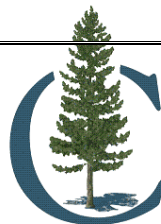

Electrical Permit Information

Any person who engages in electrical work in the City of Conroe is required to be registered and/or licensed by the City of Conroe and must obtain an electrical permit. Only a Master Electrician may secure a permit. Permits may be issued to a master electrician's designee, provided the Master Electrician submits written notarized authorization on company letterhead.

The electrical permit application may be obtained online at www.cityofconroe.org accessed from the permits and information screen.

The City of Conroe has adopted the 2014 National Electrical Code along with City amendments. To view or obtain a copy of the amendments, please reference Chapter 14 of the Conroe Code of Ordinances which is also available online.

Our permit and licensing fees are also available online; Reference City of Conroe Code of Ordinances, Appendix A.

MASTER ELECTRICIAN LICENSES/REGISTRATION

A Master Electrician license/registration is valid for a period of two years. A person desiring to be a registered City of Conroe Master Electrician must provide the following information:

1. Valid photo identification.
2. Current State of Texas (TDLR) issued Electrician License.
3. Current State of Texas (TDLR) issued State Contractors License
4. Certificate of Liability Insurance with a minimum of \$300,000.
5. A fee as set forth in Appendix A of the Conroe Code of Ordinances.
